

Student Code of Conduct and Discipline

Background and Rationale

In accordance with its mission, and Alberta legislation, Khalsa School Calgary is committed to:

- i) Providing all students with a welcoming, caring, respectful, and safe learning environment.
- ii) Maintaining a structured and nurturing environment while also respecting Sikh religion and its beliefs.
- iii) Outlining the expectations and responses to maintain exemplary student behaviour while at school, at school-related activities, or while engaging in activities that may have an impact on others in the school

Student Conduct

A) Student Expectations

Keeping with the mission and vision of Khalsa School Calgary, each student is responsible for acting positively in support of a welcoming and caring learning environment by:

- i) Acting at all times by keeping their attitudes aligned with the mission and vision of Khalsa School Calgary;
- ii) Respecting oneself and the rights of others in the school;
- iii) Conducting oneself in a manner that contributes to a welcoming, caring, respectful and safe learning environment that respects diversity and fosters a sense of belonging;
- iv) Refrain from and refuse to tolerate bullying whether in or outside of the school or school hours or electronically;
- v) Inform a responsible, trusted and caring adult in a timely manner of incidents of bullying, harassment, intimidation or other unwelcoming or uncaring acts;
- vi) Attend school regularly and punctually;
- vii) Diligently and actively being prepared to learn and actively pursue learning;
- viii) Being accountable for individual behaviours to teachers and staff;
- ix) Cooperating with school staff to make the school a positive learning environment for all; and,
- x) Knowing and following the rules of the school.
