Principal's Message

Dear Khalsa School Calgary Family,

Welcome back to another exciting school year! It's hard to believe that we're already embarking on the 2023-2024 academic journey. We extend our warm gratitude for your unwavering partnership and support as we navigate through this upcoming school year.

Staggered entry will only apply to students in grades 1-9 for the first two days. This means that half of the class will attend school on Tuesday, and the other half on Wednesday. Starting Thursday, all students will come in as usual. Kindergarten students have a slightly different schedule. Half of them will attend school on Tuesday and Thursday, while the other half will attend on Wednesday and Friday. All kindergarten students are expected to come in on Monday, September 11th. We kindly request that you adhere to these schedules as no changes will be made. This information was communicated by homeroom teachers on Friday, September 1st.

Regarding dismissal, we want to inform you that, starting immediately, all pick-up students in Division 1 (kindergarten to grade 3) and their siblings in grade 4-9 will be dismissed at 2:45 pm daily. Students in Division 2 (grades 4-6) and Division 3 (grades 7-9), as well as all bus students, will be dismissed at 3:00 pm. We kindly request that you arrive on time for pick-up. If your child's dismissal time is at 3:00 pm, please refrain from entering the parking lot earlier and arrive precisely at 3:00 pm. Our staff will be present in the parking lot to assist with this process and ensure everyone's safety.

Uniforms play an essential role in maintaining discipline and a positive learning environment. Students are required to wear the full uniform from Tuesday to Thursday this week, including all uniform items and a pair of all-black indoor shoes. Starting from Friday, students have the option to wear either their full uniform or part of their uniform, meaning they do not need to wear a tie or sweater/cardigan. On special occasions such as award ceremonies and picture days, students will be asked to wear their full uniform, and we will notify parents via email well in advance. Our uniform policy will be strictly enforced this year, and any deviation may result in a uniform infraction. We understand the importance of uniform compliance and request your support in ensuring your child is prepared accordingly.
