#### 2024-2025 Registrations

#### **Division 1 Report Card Improvements**

This year we have added an 'Executive Functioning Skills' section. These specific skills are the ones that empower students to effectively organize their thoughts, emotions, and attention span. Essentially, they are the skills students need in order to learn.

We have also added categories to the Language Arts section for grade 1-3 students. This will again provide you with more insight and aligns with the new Alberta curriculum. We hope to add categories to the other core subjects in the following year.

This year, Pink Shirt Day falls on February 28, 2024. At KSC, we are working to create a supportive community and raise greater awareness around issues like bullying. To join in on this initiative, we are asking that students and staff come to school wearing pink shirts.



### Science Fair

Khalsa School Calgary will be holding its annual Science Fair from Feb 6<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> for division II and III students. The selected students from grade 4 to 9 will be showcasing their experimental, research, and innovation projects.

The students' projects will pass through Stage 1 and Stage 2 before they are nominated for the Calgary Youth Science Fair.

<u>**Plagiarism</u></u> - All projects that are plagiarized will be <u><b>disqualified**</u> from entering CYSF and stage 2 of the judging processes.</u>



<u>Stage One</u> - The students will be presenting their science fair project digitally to their respective science teacher in the week of <u>Jan 29 to Feb 1</u>. The top five projects will be selected by their teacher to go for further judging. Students who are not present for their science fair presentation will be disqualified from getting an award. If such unfavorable circumstances arise that the student is not able to present during the week of Jan 29 to Feb 1 they will need to make arrangements with their science teacher to present at another time.

<u>Stage Two</u> - Top five projects from each class will get judged digitally during the Science Fair scheduled on **Feb 6th and Feb 7th**. We will have a team of teachers and volunteers with science backgrounds to judge these projects.

February 6	Grade 9A, 9B, 9C, 8A, 8B, 8C, 7A, and 7B	projects in person from 10:45 am - 12:00 pm on both of the days. It is requested that parents park vehicles outside the parent parking lot fence of
February 7	Grade 4A, 4B, 5A, 5B, 5C, 6A, 6B, and 6C	on the road entering the parent parkin lot.

<u>Stage Three</u> - The top projects from Grade 5 to 9 will be entered in the **Calgary Youth** Science Fair scheduled on April 11, 12 and 13th. Students will make trifolds upon reaching this stage. As we have a limited quota, only five projects can be nominated from grade 5 and 6, and six projects from grade 7 and up. The students will receive guidance from their science teachers in the months of February and March.



#### Calgary Youth Science Fair:

This event will be held at the University of Calgary and <u>one teacher from di-</u> vision two and one from division three will attend if permitted by CYSF.

**March 15** - CYSF Online Projects must be complete and students will lose access to their projects for editing

April 11- CYSF Project Set-Up (Trifold set up, no experiment set up)

April 12- CYSF Judging Day

April 13- CYSF Medal and Award Ceremony
