Growth Mindset Leaders

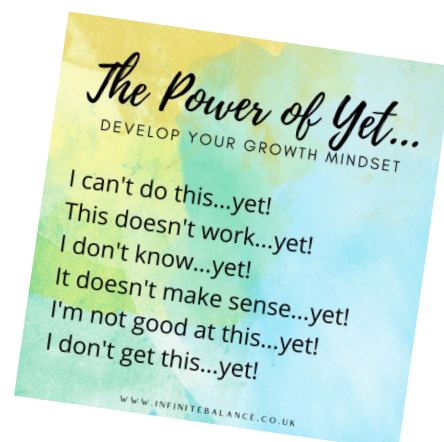
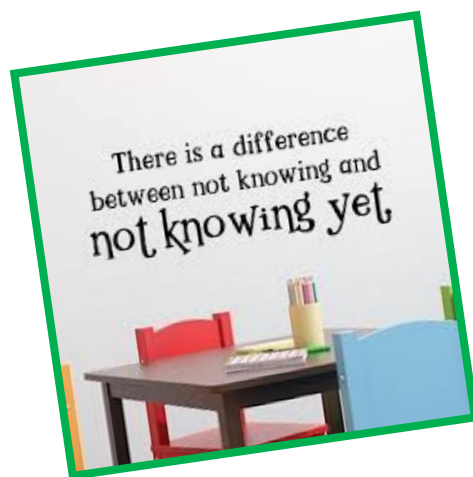
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The growth mindset theme for the month of March is

Principal's Message

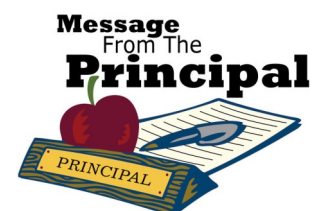
On March 14th, Khalsa School Calgary will be celebrating Sikh New Year and Hola Mohalla.
