



Registration Deadlines and Waiting List

Pre-Registration

Parents interested in enrolling their child at Khalsa School Calgary must complete a Pre-Registration Form. Submission of this form does not guarantee admission. Placement is subject to space availability and successful completion of the admissions process, including assessment requirements.

Returning Students

Families of current students must indicate whether their child will be returning for the upcoming school year during the mid-February re-registration period.

Re-registration packages must be submitted by the deadline outlined in the registration materials. Multiple reminders are issued prior to the deadline. Failure to submit by the stated deadline will result in the student's seat being released.

Late submissions will be placed in pending status and reviewed by the Principal based on space availability at that time. If the grade level has reached capacity, the student may be placed on a waitlist.

Once the re-registration period closes and returning student numbers are confirmed, available seats for new applicants are determined.

Siblings and Staff Priority

Following confirmation of returning students, admissions are processed based on space availability. Priority consideration is given to siblings of current students and children of staff members. This priority provides earlier access to the admissions process, including priority scheduling of entrance assessments ahead of non-sibling applicants.

Sibling or staff status does not guarantee placement. All applicants, including siblings and staff applicants, must meet the school's entrance assessment requirements to be considered for admission.

General Public Applicants

If seats remain after sibling and staff consideration, applications from the general public are processed according to the date and time the Pre-Registration Form was received. All applicants must meet entrance and assessment requirements.

Entrance Assessments and Seat Offers

All applicants are required to participate in an admissions assessment.

A minimum passing mark of 60% is required for admission consideration. In addition to academic readiness, the school considers a student's ability to follow direction, interact appropriately, and engage during the assessment process.

Due to the volume of applicants and the structured admissions timeline, reassessments are not offered.

There is a non-refundable assessment fee of \$25.

Once all available seats have been offered to applicants who meet admission criteria, the admissions process for that grade level is considered closed. Families will be notified when no further seats are available.

Kindergarten Admissions

Parents applying for Kindergarten must complete a Pre-Registration Form. Children must meet Alberta Education age requirements.

Sibling and staff applicants receive priority consideration in assessment scheduling; however, admission remains contingent upon space availability and successful completion of assessment requirements.

Remaining seats are offered based on the date and time the Pre-Registration Form was submitted.

Waitlist Procedure

Khalsa School Calgary maintains class size limits at each grade level. When classes reach capacity, qualified applicants may be placed on a waitlist in order of the date and time the Pre-Registration Form was received.

The school does not disclose specific waitlist positions, as placement order may change due to returning student adjustments, sibling priority considerations, or seat availability changes. When a space becomes available and an applicant reaches the top of the waitlist, the family will be contacted directly to confirm continued interest and, where applicable, to schedule an assessment.

Waitlists do not carry forward to the following school year. Families must submit a new Pre-Registration Form each year to be considered.
